Mayor Jane Castor is scheduled to speak at this monumental Ribbon-Cutting ceremony that signifies the rebirth of the West Tampa community. The long-awaited construction is now complete and is the first building to come back to the West Tampa Community after the demolition of the former North Boulevard Homes community in 2018.
